

Under the Covid 19 social distancing guidelines St Anthony's can accommodate between 25 and 30 people. At the time of writing this 12 people have said they would like to attend 9.30am Mass, so there is still plenty of space for others.

Social distancing and hygiene guidelines will have to be observed.

The wearing of masks is mandatory.

Parishioners are asked to clean their hands with hand sanitiser on entering the church (this will be provided on the entrance table).

Please take a cleansing wipe (provided) and use it to wipe down any surfaces you have touched before you leave the church.

The toilet should only be used in an emergency.

Please ensure that you are socially distancing from other parishioners.
