Covid-19 Update - Route to Recovery

Last Sunday we celebrated Mass at St Anthony's for the first time since the middle of March. The measures put in place to observe the social distancing and hygiene guidelines worked well, and as the numbers attending were not large it decided not to introduce a booking system at this stage, but to take it week by week and see how it goes.

Social distancing and hygiene guidelines:

The wearing of masks is mandatory.

Parishioners are asked to clean their hands with hand sanitiser on entering the church (this will be provided on the entrance table).

Please take a cleansing wipe (provided) and use it to wipe down any surfaces you have touched before you leave the church.

The toilet should only be used in an emergency.

Please ensure that you are socially distancing from other parishioners.

If you have any symptoms of coronavirus or have been in contact with someone who has symptoms, please stay at home.

The obligation to attend Mass has been suspended.

Those who are shielding should not come to Mass until advised it is safe to do so by the Scottish Government.

Those who are in other vulnerable groups should follow Scottish Government advice when making the decision to come to Mass.
