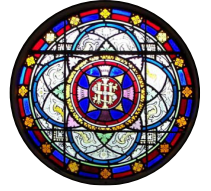

Some fruit ready, apples, pears, damsons, windfall plums - watch out for wasps!

Rule of thumb to check fruit is ripe, twist the stalk about 3 times and if the fruit drops off it is ready. Help yourself and enjoy.



Social Distancing and Hygiene Guidelines:
