The Holy Father wants to use this year as preparation for the 2025 Jubilee that will help "stimulate prayer with simplicity and in accordance with Christ's heart." To this end, dioceses are invited to remind people of the centrality of both individual prayer and community prayer. In addition, Parishes are also encouraged to use their own initiatives to stimulate prayer.

Ash Wednesday falls on the **14**th **of February** this Year. As Catholics this is a very important time of Year and I urge you to note this date, to make every effort to attend mass on Ash Wednesday and to think seriously about how to approach the Lenten season in general.
